Qualifications:

- Graduation from an accredited college or university with major work in Landscape Architecture, and a minimum of 2 years experience.
- Knowledge of CADD, design and other business-related software.
- General knowledge of current landscape architectural theory and concepts, site design, state building and ADA accessibility laws and familiarity with engineering practices and environmental analysis.
- Ability to listen and effectively execute assignments with minimal oversight or direction.
- Ability to effectively manage work time to help meet project deadlines.

Position Description:

Under general supervision, performs routine tasks and duties requiring application of standard techniques and procedures in carrying out a sequence of related landscape design tasks.

Specific duties:

- Prepares plans, exhibits and graphics for presentations using CADD and other methods.
- Prepares studies and reports as directed, collecting data and preparing preliminary landscape related plans.
- Under supervision, should be skilled in the production of planting plans, irrigation plans, construction layout plans, grading and drainage plans, and construction details and specifications.
- Responsible for coordination with clients, agency staff and other consultants regarding routine issues.
- Responsible for specific components of a project with increasing complexity.
- May direct and review the work of Junior Landscape Designers or Landscape Design Technicians.
