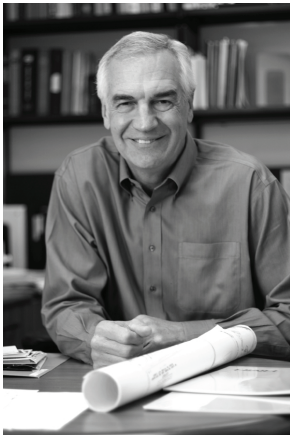

Bill's special expertise is managing design of major transportation projects involving freeway interchanges, railroad grade separations, arterial road improvements and bridge structures. His recent achievements include the Bailey Avenue Extension, a \$45 million transportation facility that includes a new U.S. 101 freeway interchange and a railroad grade separation to serve the North Coyote Valley Campus Industrial Area in South San Jose. He is currently involved in overseeing project development and PS&E preparation for the U.S. 101

Operational Improvements, a \$63 Million CMIA-funded project to reconfigure the Tully Road Interchange, add a southbound lane and make other upgrades at a highly congested location in San Jose's Evergreen area.

One of Bill's most challenging assignments was serving as Project Manager for the County of Santa Clara on the controversial Route 17 Interchange at Lexington Reservoir. He participated in public hearings, community meetings and led the Project Development Team to select an interchange location and configuration, which was successfully constructed, by the County and Caltrans.

Bill has experience with civil works for light rail projects like the Tasman West Light Rail project and the Capitol LRT Corridor. He also managed the design of airfield improvements associated with the San Jose International Airport Terminal A Expansion project and led HMM's efforts on the San Francisco Airport's North & South International Parking Garages, Concourse H/BART Station and Rental Car Facility Garage.

Early in his career, his assignments included design of on-site grading, drainage, roadways and parking for large industrial developments, planning and design of major storm drainage facilities, as well as contract administration and construction inspection for public works facilities in Santa Cruz County.
